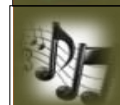

PRESSING ON BY PASTORYEMISI BAMGBOSE PHILLIPIANS 3:14



Philippians 3:14 - *"I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus."*

To press-on is to move on towards and take possession of a goal.

To press-on is to exert deliberate and maximum effort for the purpose of reaching or attaining a goal, just as a runner in a race drives for the finish line.

II Timothy 2:5 - "And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully."

To press-on is to urge in motion; to urge forward with force.

We are to press-on in our quest to be like Jesus in all manner of things.

Everyone in life presses towards something; some towards the goal in order to win a prize, whilst others exert energy to achieve academic goals. Some exert energy in the field of medicine, while some exert physical energy in training as a footballer or wrestler. Many of us want to be the best in our chosen field, therefore we put all of our efforts in achieving this fete. Athletes, for example, receive medals for various categories, and many army generals are decorated with medals of honour. Those in academic fields receive accolades in honour of their achievements, but to get to this point they sacrifice time and efforts to achieve their goals.

Nothing enhances a man's work like good recognition of the efforts made.

Ephesians 4:15

We must press-on to maturity as believers, and we are to grow up and become achievers.

We must move towards the race that is set before us in order to achieve our purpose.

Every Christian is in the race of life. The race begins at birth and ends at death or when rapture happens.

This will require us to strive towards attaining the goal set by the Creator for us to attain whilst we are on this earthly journey.

Anyone in a race must run with certainty and precision. They must run according to the rules of the game otherwise they risk being disqualified.

To press-on does not allow you to be distracted or to lose focus.

There are a lot of things calling for your attention, and there are many distractions and distractors. A great deal of these are set up as barriers by the devil to steal your time, such as weariness, tiredness, discouragement, sickness, and foolishness.

God, on the other hand, has put in place things that will help us remain focused whilst on the journey, like, the help of the Holy Spirit, other believers, and the cloud of witnesses.

We must also remember that God has set up the race before us, and we must take time to know what has been set in order not to run another man's race. Find out what has been set up for you. Know what needs to be known about your own journey.

If you run another person's race, you will lose your reward and may even get disqualified.

To press-on may mean focusing on what matters to you and not to others.

We must find out the reason for our very existence and only then can we run well and lawfully.

You must have the knowledge and know the rules of the game.

To press-on successfully, you must let go of all the weight and sin that easily beset us.

Hebrews 12:1

Be mindful of the fact that there will be things that try to dissuade you from pursuing your assignments, like past achievements, yesterday's glory, and things that may not necessarily be sinful but are not needful or helpful.

Find out what God has set before you and know every detail concerning it, just like an athlete will understand the rules of their sport, only then will you run with the understanding and certainty to win.

THINGS YOU MUST KNOW ABOUT PRESSING ON:

- Understand your assignment
- Map out the details of your journey
- Avoid all forms of distraction

- Resist every form of opposition
- Reject your past failures
- Allow the Holy Spirit to guide your steps
- Leave your comfort zone for the unknown territory
- Learn how to manage risk and trust the Holy Spirit in all issues

Going forward against the odds to do something requires a strong will and discipline. This is going against every obstacle that stands in your way and forcing your way through. Pressing on may mean pushing against the wind. An example of this is making sure you go to church, even when the weather is unfavourable and harsh.

Matthew 9:20-25

The woman with the issue of blood pressed on to touch Jesus' garment - she pressed on until she got her healing.

Life is not fair, so therefore, you must choose to press-on to complete the project.

Pressing on to an excellent life, may present its thorns on the way, and there may be valleys, mountains, giants in the land, and secure walls, but despite all these barriers, we must press-on to occupy the promise land.

Exodus 14:15 - "And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward:"

When the children of Israel got to the Red Sea, God told them to go forward despite the huge obstacle of the sea. They were to move on and trust God to take them to the other side without drowning.

God expected them to use their faith to trust the One that had made the promise.

Do not remain on the side of caution as the enemy may be in hot pursuit.

When we press-on, we are making progress against all odds.

When you take a step of faith, the attitude of fear will step to the side.

When you are confronted with many obstacles, that is when you should choose to go forward as such obstacles are a sign of what awaits you on the other side.

Joshua 6:1-20

When they got to Jericho, God instructed them to walk around the city once for six days, but seven times on the seventh day and then shout. As they shouted, the wall came down and all opposition was demolished. Likewise, in your life, as you press-on, all walls of opposition shall crumble and you will conquer that mountain.

We are to press-on the upward way. Even when the roads are likely to be hard and rough, always remember that our Captain has gone ahead of us as a proof that victory is assured in Him.

We are to press-on into maturity.

II Corinthians 3:18

When we behold Him, then we will be transformed from our current image to His perfect image, becoming as He is.

Let us be like Apostle Paul. Despite all the beatings, ship-wrecks, adversities, fake brethren, and persecutions, he persevered to the end.

Hebrews 10:39 - "But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul."

The above scripture tells us that we are not of them that draw back.

John 6:68 - "Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life."

Only Jesus has the words of eternal life, and our desire and aim is to continue to press-on until we become just like He is.

This act of pressing on requires sacrifice on our part. It is not an easy road, and only the determined, focused and courageous will win the race.

God has set a goal for each and everyone of us. Your determination to press-on will take you there.

Do not dwell on yesterday's glory, as it will stop you from running. Do not consider tomorrow's challenges, as they will prevent you from moving forward.

Your life outcome will be a proof of the decision you made.

The best way to become an achiever is to adopt the same thought as Paul, that you have fought a good fight and kept the faith and your crown awaits you on the other side of eternity.

II Timothy 4:7-8 - "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing"

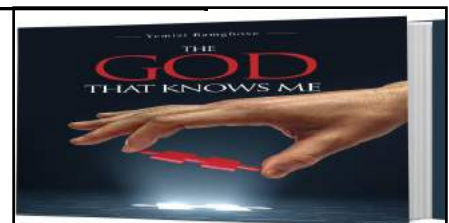
