REDEMPTION BY PASTOR YEMISI BAMGBOSE EPHESIANS 1:7



What is redemption? It is the system of buying back. Redemption is the act of being saved from sin into freedom.

Redemption is made possible by Jesus Christ through His sacrificial death; it was purchased by His power, to set us all free from the bondage of sin. Jesus saved us from the wages of sin, which is eternal death, by His blood.

Redemption is the act of buying back or repurchasing what was previously forfeited or lost.

Redemption is an act of redeeming or atoning for a fault or mistake of another; it is the state of being redeemed from sin, satan, and all bondage, by rescue and deliverance.

Through the sin of Adam, all mankind lost their rights of freedom to satan, and as a result, became bound by sin, sickness, diseases, death and eternal separation from God.

God by His act of mercy put the plan of redemption into place, where man will be bought back from the clutches of satan, the devil.

Man lost his position in God because of sin, and Christ, by His death, purchased our freedom back with His blood.

Redemption brought us salvation from sin and all its consequences.

Redemption brought us freedom and liberty.

Redemption is every believer's birthright, and it is what we will always need to live in the freedom of God's love.

Redemption has given us freedom to be like Jesus in likeness and deeds.

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of law.

Galatians 3:13-14

We are redeemed to become the sons of God.

Romans 8:13

By redemption, we can command the devil and he must obey us.

We are now spirit beings by redemption, no more just human beings. We have a vehicle, which is the flesh, and our spirit, which was once dead, that has now come back alive after meeting Jesus.

New birth by redemption is a new being (wearing a fleshy clothing).

By redemption, we are now seated in heavenly places, far above principalities and powers, in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:5-8

Salvation provides the divine privilege that allows us to be seated together with Christ in heavenly places, far above principalities and powers.

Ephesians 1:20-22

We are seated far above the forces of wickedness.

We are not redeemed to be struggling with issues of life, neither are we redeemed to suffer circumstances. Rather, we are redeemed, and are on top of all circumstances and above all issues of life. Redemption in Christ

makes it a brand-new day for us.

John 8:23

When He arose from the dead, He brought us with Him where we can command on what He has said.

We cannot do the work He has done unless we understand His redemptive power.

We have been redeemed to be in command and not to be dominated over.

By redemption, we now carry the presence of God in the person of Jesus Christ within us. His name is Immanuel, God with us, and we carry God's presence, which is the zeal of signs and wonders.

When Israel came out of Egypt, God's presence dominated them. He was in their midst as The Mighty, Terrible One.

He subdued their enemies and gave them food, water and shelter.

Psalm 114:2-4

As the sea saw Him and fled, from now on, trouble will see you and disappear. Everything that troubled you before will begin to tremble at His appearance.

Colossians 1:27

Christ in us, the hope of glory. We now have authority over shame and reproach in life.

Redemption has made us a terror to the kingdom of darkness; when they attempt to mention our names for evil, thunder strikes them down.

The ever-abiding consciousness of God's presence, which He has given to us, must be guided jealousy.

Redemption came to validate the fact that we are children of God, and that we are each a god in the similitude of our Father.

From today, no devil or agent of darkness can scare us anymore.

John 10:34-36 - "Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods? If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken; say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?".

It has been written in their laws that we are gods.

What makes God God, is that He is the Judge of all. Vengeance belongs to Him, and He reacts against unjust situations.

Every born-again child of God is redeemed as a sign and wonder to our world.

This month, we must be sure of what redemption has made of each of us. Each child of God has the redemptive offer that comes along with His salvation.

With this understanding, we must begin to operate with confidence as we get to know and discover the things that put believers in command of the supernatural.

We must be sure not to lose our supernatural identity in Christ. As when one has stayed too long with the natural man, he/she can lose their supernatural identity.

Daniel 11:32

We are redeemed as lions, as Jesus is the Lion of the Tribe of Judah. Jesus said, "as my Father has sent me, so have I sent you."

The days of being cheated and robbed is over in each of our lives forever.

Jesus has not paid that huge price for nothing, and we are redeemed to stay in command and be in charge of all He has put under our control.

What has redemption done for us?

- Redemption has given us power to operate in the supernatural.
- Redemption has made us free, and we are no longer bound by sin.
- Redemption has brought us into Abrahamic blessings.


