

GALATIANS 3:13A

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law"

Song:

There is a Redeemer, Jesus God's own Son,

Precious Lamb of God, Messiah, Oh for the sinners slain.

Thank you oh my Father, For giving us, Your Son,

And leaving Your Spirit 'til the work on earth is done.

To redeem means to rescue from danger, to deliver, to set free from the claws of the enemies.

According to the passage given in **Galatians 3:13**, "Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us, for it is written, cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree"

Christ has rescued us from the curse that came as a result of the law because He took our position in order that blessings may be accrued to our account.

The law condemned but the Spirit triumphs by grace.

The breaking of law leads to punishment, but Jesus by His blood brought pardon and forgiveness to us.

What are the things that Christ redeemed us from? He has redeemed us from the penalty of sin. The Bible says in **Romans 6:23** that "the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord". The penalty that Jesus redeemed us from is eternal and physical death.

He took our penalty of sin upon Himself in order to free us to serve the living God.

The payment for our sins is death, and Jesus paid that penalty in full with His life when He died for us on the cross of Calvary.

A soul that sins will surely die; that was the verdict for sin, but by the death of Jesus, life eternal is granted to those that will accept Him as their personal Lord and Saviour.

He redeemed us from the curse of the law.

Deuteronomy 27:15-26; 28:15-68.

Deuteronomy 27:26 says "cursed be he that confirmed not all the words of this law to do them, and all the people shall say Amen".

What Jesus did for us is unmeasurable and unquantifiable.

He has redeemed us so that we should no longer live by the dictate of those rules and are free to serve God in an acceptable manner.

Christ has redeemed us from bondage to serve the living God - **Galatians 4:3**, **Hebrews 2:15** He has redeemed us from the power of darkness and translated us into His kingdom of light.

Colossians 1:13.

He has redeemed us from iniquity - Titus 2:14.

He has redeemed us from sickness and diseases - Matthew 9:35.

He has redeemed us from poverty and lack.

He has redeemed us from the control of the devil and his agents.

He has redeemed us from sorrow and failure.

He has redeemed us from defeat.

He has redeemed us from the slave market - Galatians 4:9

He has redeemed us from bondage and chains.

He has redeemed us from unrest.

Jeremiah 50:34 "Their Redeemer is strong, the Lord of hosts is His name, He shall thoroughly please their cause, that He may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon."

Jesus has not redeemed us for us to continue living in our sins, and He has not shed His precious blood for us to bastardise the essence of His death on the cross of Calvary.

He has redeemed us, so that we can live in newness of life, a life of righteousness, of purity, of holiness, and a life void of offences.

Hebrews 10:26 - If we continue in sin after we have been delivered and redeemed by Jesus, of what benefit was His death to us?

We need to remember that He was ridiculed, spat on, beaten with many stripes until His flesh was ripped off, and finally He was nailed to the cross for our freedom.

Galatians 4:5

He redeemed us from the law in order to adopt us into His family.

lesus by redemption gave us power to be called the sons of God.

As we have received Christ Jesus, we should also walk in Him.

Colossians 2:6-7

You are to be rooted in Christ Jesus, attached to Him by fellowship and be established in Him.

We are to take on His identity, His character, and personality etc.

Finally, Jesus paid your debt and mine in full. Why? Because His Father has raised Him as a horn of salvation for us.

Even as we celebrate this Easter, let us be grateful to God for that ultimate sacrifice He paid, the life He gave, the joy that comes as a result of being free from all the horrible situations and circumstances that has kept many in captivity for so many years.
