ECCLESIASTES 3:1

“To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:”

We are in a new season of life as this is the last month of year 2016.

We know that seasons happen in sequence.

Sowing time is a seasons for sowing, planting, investing. It's not the time for harvest.

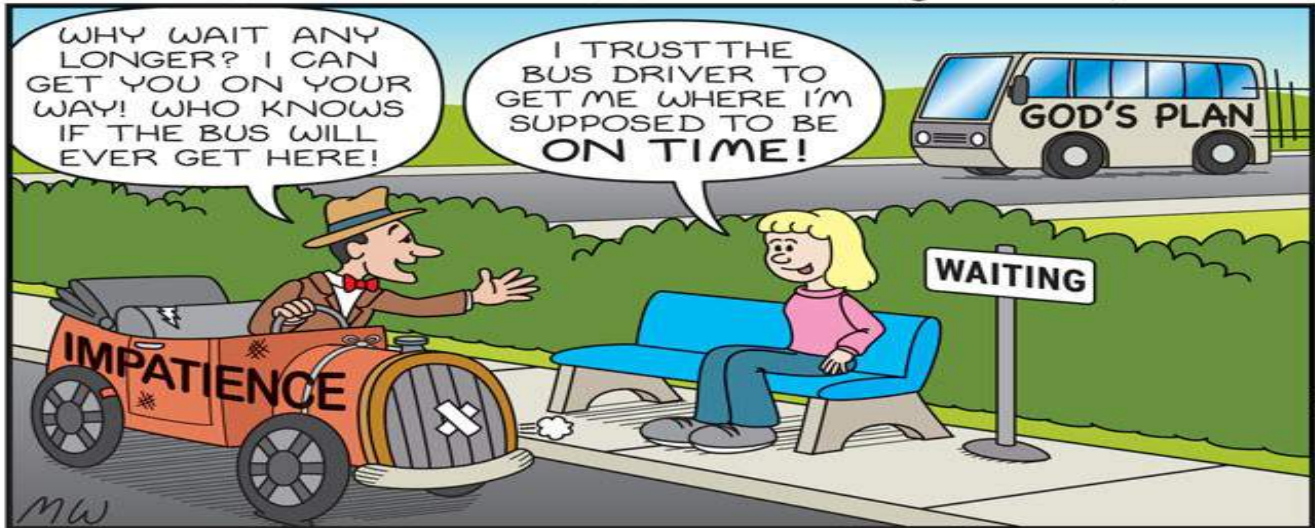

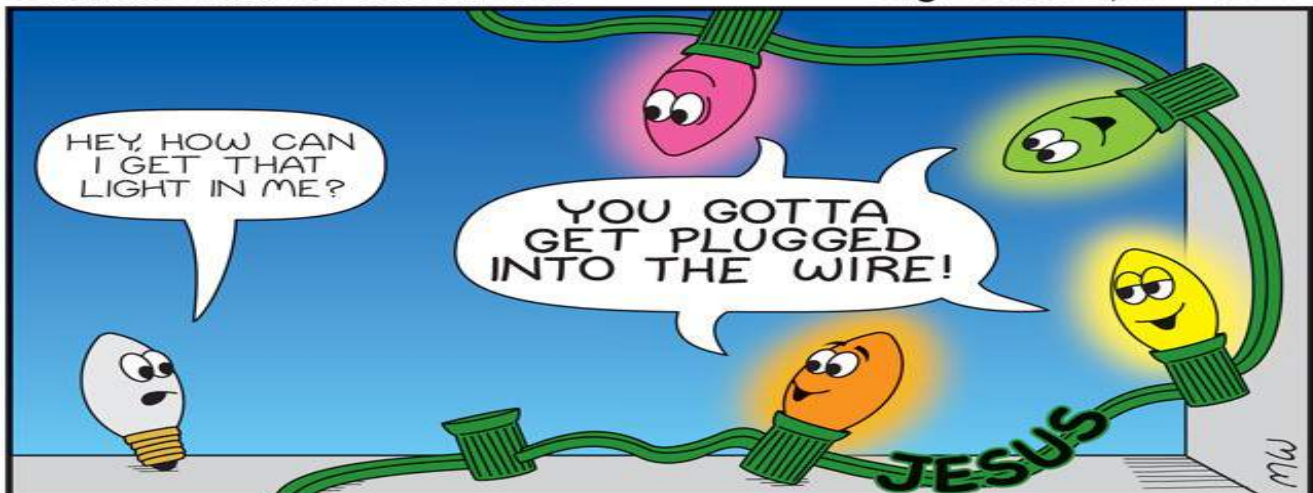

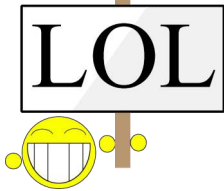
