

HEBREWS 9:11-28

His Redemptive Power.

Redemptive means redemption from the control of flesh and that of the devil.

Redemption means deliverance by sacrifice.

Hebrews 9:14,28

Christ by the reason of giving Himself as sacrifice has redeemed us all from the following:

DAY 31


Father, every trace of un-brokenness in my life, please uproot today. Break me, mould me and make me what You want me to be.
