Matthew 5:14-16 "Ye are the light of the world. A city that is Light enhances your speed and eases your journey. When set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven."

After, many attempts to get pregnant and desperately alone, we tried all we could to have a baby but all to no avail '. The doctors told me I couldn't get pregnant due to the medications I was using for my blood pressure. Sometimes in June 2011, my doctor referred me for a CT scan because I noticed my stomach was getting bigger thinking I was pregnant, I made up my mind to go for the winning women conference in High Leigh that took place in July 2011. I came back from High Leigh and met a letter from my doctor asking me to see her. Come November 2011, I went to my GP to check my blood pressure as usual and he was shocked at the reading, my blood pressure came back normal. Couple of weeks later, I realised I was pregnant.

pressure, fibroid and low placenta, I came for my School of Disciple class on Saturday the 14th of July after my exam, I took permission to attend my appointment at the hospital to check my blood pressure as usual, but to my surprise they called my consultant, who told me I have to be admitted due to low placenta and high blood pressure.

I was told the fibroid was getting bigger than the baby and had no room for the baby to grow anymore, so they have to do a Caesarean Section for me. I later called my Pastor and told her and she prayed with me.

Throughout that week the open heaven topics was like God was just speaking to me the Monday before the surgery Daddy GO was talking about the importance of the communion and how often we should take it, I made up my mind and asked my hubby to call Pastor and asked her if she can come and administer the communion for me before the surgery. She came, prayed and administered the communion. I was told I would be the third in line for surgery the next day but I said to pastor, God being whom He is, I might be the first for the Caesarean section and God's willing I was the first.

5. Pay extra on home mortgage

You will add equity to your home, reduce the amount of interest paid over the term of the loan, and reduce the length of the loan if you pay extra monthly on your home mortgage. Pre-employment programme to help those unemployed and on benefits

In the UK the figure for those unemployed and on benefits now stands at 2.65 million. Long-term unemployment is up about 50% on the year. Unemployed women aged 50 - 64 has risen by 27%. There are now 1.03 million young people unemployed, which stands at 22%, but the figure for young black men has increased by 70% in the last three years and is now 48%.

To help these unfortunates in our community, the RCCG Winners Way Church is participating in a new government Pre-employment 10-day Customer Service programme leading to a level 1 certificate. It is available starting in August, free of charge to anyone 19 and upwards who is registered unemployed and on benefits. Let's face it all employers are looking for people with these skills. The objective is to get 60% of those who join the programme into employment and on to a level 2 Apprenticeship. Contact Pastor Yemisi or Dcn Sheidu to enroll and for further information.

For employers in the community, we make this plea. The country will move out of recession and your business will move up. Don't leave these 2.65 million people on that island of despair called unemployment. Take them with you! There is an Apprenticeship grant scheme for eligible employers with an incentive of £1,500 towards taking on a 16 – 24 year old. Consider taking on someone who has completed the Customer Service pre-employment course. There are no recruitment costs. 


