“MADE FOR THE PALACE”

PSALM 144:12



Our children are made for the palace, not as servants but as the one in charge and in control. The Bible gave the description that our sons may be as plants grown up in their youth. This means they will be full of life, strength and vitality, and they will be pure, powerful, useful and visible. Our youths are to be seen as the leaders of good inventions, as solution providers and counsellors, giving right and correct advice to those who seek for help. Our youths are to be full of God's Word and they are meant to live lives that are immersed in Jesus.

Princes and princesses are not wimps, but they must be of a good character and that is the hallmark of kingship. They are to be courageous in the face of fear and anxiety. They are to be as bold as a lion and as gentle as a dove. When they speak, their words should convict their hearers and their wisdom should outwit their critics.

Daughters are described as pillars sculptured in a palace style. This means in their dressing, it must show to those around them that they are respectable princesses and not prostitutes. They must show modesty in their adornment, and they must be caring and forgiving. Their speech must be seasoned with salt and flavour, and they must never be vulgar in their speech.

One made for the palace does not lie or cheat, neither does he/she indulge in unruly behaviour. Their lifestyle is dictated by the King, and this shows in all they do and say. They influence and are not to be influenced by corrupt communication.

In education, they must be hard working. In character, they must be above reproach. They must honour and obey God's constituted authority. They must honour and obey their parents so that their days may be long on the earth.

Those made for the palace are not ordinary youth tossed by the winds of strange doctrines as they are rooted well in God. Those made for the palace do not copy others in behaving badly as they set the pace in good behaviour. Those made for the palace do not feel intimidated by 'no-ones' as God is their source of strength. Those made for the palace have the capacity to change what is seen as the norm to the ideal. Those made for the palace are carriers of God's presence and are also preservers of His glory. Those made for the palace are those willing to use their youthful days to serve their Maker and Redeemer - **Ecclesiastes 12:1.**

Those made for the palace are not afraid of a giant boasting in their human ability, but they are full of God's promises to subdue mountains set before them - **1 Samuel 17:45-51.**

Those made for the palace are always seeking for ways to please God only. Jesus was even referred to as a plant growing up with reference to a tender plant from the ground.

This means our children are delicate and we should handle them with total and complete care – **Isaiah 53:2a**.

Parents are to train their children in the ways of the Lord and when they are old, they will not depart from it – **Proverbs 22:6**. We, as adults and parents, should speak words that will build up the princely character in them. We should not destroy them by our hurtful words or by our negative criticism. Criticism should be constructive and it should help bring about positive improvements and results. We should not starve them of the Word of life that can enable their growth. We are to nurture them tenderly, water their gifts, and pray for their futures. We need to show them forgiveness by forgiving their wrong doings. We are also called to love them tenderly and unconditionally.

Hallmarks of their character

Below is a list of hallmarks of the character of Godly children, youth and young people.

1. Their voices must be heard where it matters – **Isaiah 49:1-2**
2. They are to be filled with the Spirit of God in wisdom, knowledge and understanding of visions and dreams – **Daniel 1:17**
3. They are to demonstrate their God given abilities wherever they find themselves – **Daniel 2:23**
4. They are not to compromise their stand in God – **Daniel 3:16-18**
5. They are born to lead others to God.
6. They are to shun ungodliness – **Proverbs 31:1-6**
7. They are to speak with the enemies at the gate – **Psalms 127:3-5**
8. They are created to be true worshippers of God.
9. They must listen to and adhere to the instructions from their parents – **Proverbs 1:8-9**
10. They are to show stability and reliability in all they do.

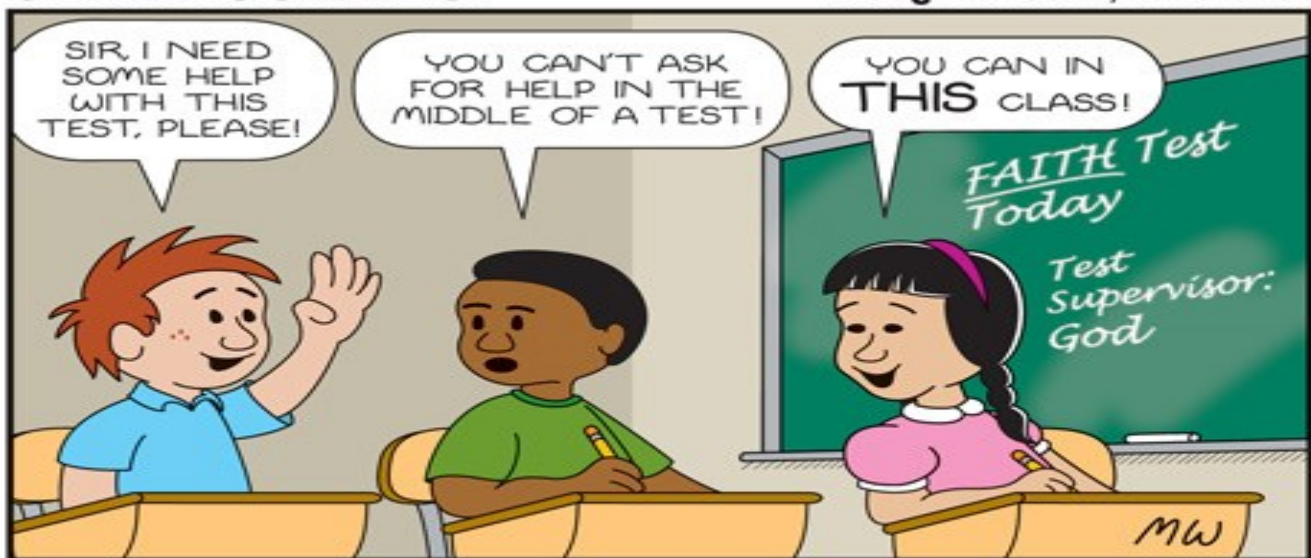
