"With Wings Like An Eagle" by Pastor Yemisi Bamgbose

"But those that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength They shall mount up wings as eagles

They shall run and not be weary

They shall walk and not faint." Isaiah 40:31 KJV

To fly means to soar in a high altitude. Birds need wings to fly, as cars need tyres to move. Eagles are not just ordinary birds, but are special as they can fly in very high altitudes. Eagles are not afraid of height, nor afraid of the sun, does not dwell on low levels at all.

Having wings like an eagle is to enable you to soar powerfully without fear or being afraid of anything. Eagles are noted for their broad wings and their powerful soaring flight. An Eagle's emblem represents power. We know that wings are for flying as legs are for walking. The one flying is exerting less energy than the fellow walking. If any fellow is going to cover grounds for God they will require an ability to fly as it will enable them to cover a lot of grounds in less time. The prerequisite for mounting up with wings like an eagle is to wait upon the Lord. When you wait upon someone, they dictate the terms of the waiting and not the one waiting on them. You don't leave their presence until they dismiss you to go or you have received your request. Waiting requires patience, expectation and attentiveness. For example, a waiter waits on the customers the waiter can never be in a hurry or in haste in dealing with the customers he or she is waiting upon. The host or hostess waits on their guest to see that their needs are met. Your waiting requires your total being as you can never be absent minded in your waiting.

It's only when we wait upon the Lord that we can renew our strength, both spiritual, physical and emotional, strength is renewed as we wait upon the Lord. Please note that it is the waiter that needs or expecting something from the one being waited on. Your ability to get something out of your waiting depends on your attitude to the person being waited upon. In waiting, you must have a clear agenda and it must be an agenda that goes with the person you are going to wait upon. The scripture tells us that those who wait on the Lord? Not those who wait on their prime minister, or president, their husband or wife, parents, or their boss. There is nothing wrong in waiting on these people, but what you can get out of your waiting is earthly and temporal. But when you chose to wait on the Lord, there are no limitations to what you will get out of it. The one who is waited upon is the, I AM THAT I AM Exodus 3:14.

The one being waited upon has absolute power, authority, resources etc.

When you are waiting on Him, the implication is Lord I know you have my solution in Your hands and I will wait until You give me. We are at His mercy because according to *Romans* 9:15. In order to get the maximum benefit of your waiting, you will have to fulfil His conditions. God controls both the timing and seasons for your blessings. Some of the benefits are to mount up with wings like eagle. Renewal of strength just as eagles required two wings to fly as one wing will not be sufficient in flying. In order for us to engage in flying for Jesus our wings must be complete and strong. Having one wing will make you an abnormal bird that is not better than the ones walking.

There are many benefits attached to being able to fly:

 You have a better view of situation or environment
You will be able to assess your circumstances better than those on the ground

5). You will be able to fly above mountains and valleys

6). You will reach your destination faster than those running or walking

7). You will become untouchable to every foul spirits that crawls

8). You can cover your journey at lesser time than others

9). Winds enhances your speed

10). You use less energy

Father's Day At WWD by Deji Dosumu

Father's Day at Winners' Way Dartford on June 17th 2012

A day we celebrated all fathers in our church and a day we review, re-assess and remind ourselves: Who is a Father? And how a Father is expected to behave.

FATHER is defined as a male parent of any type of offspring. This could be: 1] the biological Father 2] the non biological Father

A father is known as a man who exercises paternal care over other persons. Most fathers are naturally protective, supportive, and responsible and are able to provide a number of significant benefits to themselves, their communities, and their children. Involved fathers offer developmentally specific provisions to their sons and daughters throughout the life cycle and are impacted themselves by their doing so. Active father figures have a key role to play in reducing behaviour problems in boys and psychological problems in young women. For example, children who experience significant father involvement tend to exhibit higher scores on assessments of cognitive development, enhanced social skills and fewer behaviour problems.

Meaning of Father / Fatherhood:

F: Faithful, Fearless, Fervent, Focus,

A: Approachable, Accessible, And Available

T: Teacher, Tutor

H: Honourable, Helper

E: Experience, Expert, Excellent, and Example

R: Respectable, Reasonable, Responsible, Resourceful, Role model

F: A father therefore must be <u>faithful</u> to God and his immediate family. He must be <u>fearless</u>, <u>fervent</u> and remain <u>focused</u> on his God giving assignment.

A: A father must be <u>approachable</u>, not detachable from his children; he must remain <u>accessible</u> and not aloof. He must be <u>available</u> at all times and not occasionally.

T: A father must be a good teacher to his family, he must be able to tutor and mentor his children and family, he must honour God and respect men.

H: A father must be a <u>honourable</u> man, a man of his word, ready to <u>help</u> when necessary; he must not be a dictator who does not get his hands dirty on housework.

E: A father must have enough <u>experience</u> of his divine assignment; he must study the bible in order to become an <u>expert</u> in what he does. He must be a good <u>example</u> of an <u>excellent</u> father.

R: A father must be <u>respectable</u>, <u>reasonable</u> in his expectations, <u>responsible</u> person, very <u>resourceful</u> and a very good <u>role model</u>. He must direct his home affairs by example and he must lead by example.

Responsibilities of a Father:

Ephesians 6:4 says "And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord."

The Christian father is really an instrument in God's hand. The whole process of instruction and discipline must be that which God commands and which He administers, so that His authority should be brought into constant and immediate contact with the mind, heart, and conscience of children. The human father should never present himself as the ultimate authority to determine truth and duty. It is only by making God the teacher and ruler on whose authority everything is done that the goals of education can best be attained.

A Christian father should take full responsibility for his family as a spiritual father of his home by behaving sensibly and not neglecting his spiritual, physical and social responsibilities. As honours begins at home. He must be a good example of love by loving God and his family.

It is his responsibility to teach his children to love God, to respect the authorities, to provide, protect and direct the affairs of his home. He must be a man of integrity and of honest report. He must live up to his God giving assignment and do it with joy and a sense of accountability to God. **Joshua 24:15** says "Choose today who you will serve, but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord

Ten Ways to Save Money

Most families are looking for ways to save money, and financial consultants by the hundreds feel that they have the money-saving methods for which these families are looking. These include everything from

refinancing home mortgages, taking home equity loans, and getting low-interest charge cards to no-down payment investment property, and borrowing against retirement funds.

In evaluating the multiplicity of suggestions and moneysaving options, 10 suggestions seem to be advised more than any others: (1) give to God; (2) start small; (3) put money into a company retirement account; (4) monitor ATM withdrawals; (5) pay off charges and loans; (6) pay extra on home mortgage; (7) pay off car loan; (8) open an IRA; (9) evaluate life insurance; and (10) be accountable for your money.

1. Give to God

When we recognize that God owns everything and all blessings come from Him, our role as managers, or stewards, becomes evident. Part of being a good steward is giving back to God a portion of what He has entrusted to us. It is not that God needs our money. Rather, giving serves as an external, material testimony that God owns both the material and spiritual things of our lives and that He is the source of all our supply.

Malachi 3:10 is the first place that really directs the tithe: "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house." In the Old Testament, the storehouse was a physical place where the Jews would deliver their offerings of grain and animals. Ideally, the church should serve as the storehouse in God's economy today.

Although the tithe is an indicator of our obedience to God's laws, He is looking for the right attitude in our giving. If there were not a willingness to give back what, He has entrusted to us, then even giving above the tithe would be of little use. So, since the tithe's purpose is to be a testimony of God's ownership, each believer should give bountifully and cheerfully.



Most financial experts feel that we need to save at least 5 percent, and preferably 10 percent, of our income and place it into an interest-bearing, liquid savings account. However, don't give up if you're not able to put aside 5 or 10 percent. Establishing a saving habit and saving consistently will eventually add up; even as little as \$5 per pay period will accumulate. Once saving becomes a habit, set as your savings goal a maintained savings

account of at least three to six months' income. This will prevent borrowing when unexpected expenses arise or in case of a period of illness or unemployment.

3. Put money into a retirement account

If it is available, sign up with your workplace's 401(k), 403(b), or similar retirement plan in which your company will contribute matching funds to the plan in your name. The most common match is 50 cents on the dollar. If this is the case for you, you will get an immediate 50 percent return on your contributions.

4. Monitor ATM withdrawals

Decide how much money you will take out each week or each month and make it last; discipline yourself to stick to your decision. Try to decrease the amount withdrawn every month. If you discover that you have money left over, deposit it into your savings account.



Day 29


Father, multiply and sanctify our resources, touch the heart of our leaders not to be deceitful and wasteful and let them fear you to the end in Jesus name.
