“COME! ALL THINGS ARE READY”

Matthew 22:1-14



We have:

- The King
- The invitees
- The servants
- The King's son
- The preparations
- The provisions
- The wedding day

Invitations were sent out for those the King wanted at his son's wedding. He had made preparations and provisions ready in abundance for those that had been invited. Jesus spoke about this parable to illustrate the importance of this invitation and the responses of those invited. The King in this story is God and the invitees are those who have been called to come and partake in the wedding of His Son. He has killed the fatted cow and all provisions are now ready.

He sent His servants to call those that were invited to the wedding, but they would not come. Again, He sent His servants to inform them that He had made provisions for them. He was basically saying 'behold, I have prepared my dinner, killed a fatted oxen and ALL THINGS ARE READY. Come to the marriage!' All they needed to do was to COME.

But they made light the invitation. They made excuses. Some went their way to the farm, to the market and to their businesses. Others took and ill-treated and killed the King's servants, so the King sent His armies to slew all the murderers.

So instead of the original invitees, the King sent His servants to go and gather other people from highways and bid them come to the wedding, as those who were originally invited were not worthy.

From this story, it can be seen that different types of guests were invited, and these guests all fall in one of four categories. The four categories are:

1. THE UNWILLING INVITEES

Isaiah 1:19 says, *"If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land."*

They were unwilling; hence they were excluded from the King's party. Some are unwilling to prosper. Many do not want to prosper for the fear of losing Heaven, which is not the truth, but only an excuse. They have linked prosperity to hell and poverty to holiness. The truth is, one cannot miss Heaven as a result of prosperity if achieved in a Godly manner.

Many are also unwilling to be well. They prefer to be in their state of ill health as they fear the loss of their benefits.

2. THE DISOBEDIENT INVITEES

'Those who blatantly refused to come; full stop'

Deuteronomy 28:1-2

Some are unwilling to obey God. If you want God to bless you, you must obey His commandments. For example, the Word of God says *'give and it shall be given to you'*. How should one give? He said *'give cheerfully and bountifully'*. For you to fully benefit from the Word of God, you must obey in accordance to how, where and when He wanted it to be done.

3. THE ANTAGONISTIC INVITEES

Those who shows resistance and opposition to God and His word.

2 Kings 7:1-2

Elisha said 'by this time tomorrow', but it was thought by the officer that the prophesy was too impossible to come to pass, and because of this, he did not partake of the prophesy.

Some of us are antagonistic to God, not by our words, but by our actions (**John 14:14-15**). We show our enmity to God by disobeying Him and by not believing His Word sent to us. The man in the story outlined in **2 Kings 7** died a painful death. He saw the miracle but never partook of it according to the word of the man of God.

Babies are ready for the barren, and husbands and wives are ready for the single sisters and brothers. For those of us that want a miracle from God, we need to remember that we are dealing with a Holy God.

4. THE WILLING INVITEES

'Those that are willing and obedient and not antagonistic to God.'

The King has made all things ready for the willing and obedient invitees.

Psalm 115:3 - God is Sovereign and He is the Almighty God. He deals in time and season. God has set a timetable for everything He does - **Luke 1:5-17**.

How do I know my season?

There are two things that will tell you your season has come, and they are as follows:

The uncommon urge to be generous to God and others.

This is a sign that your day of miracle has come. In **2 Chronicles 1:6-12**, God gave Solomon the urge to offer a thousand burnt offerings to Him. This was done in order for God to bless him. Solomon gave what no other person before him had given to God, and he got what no other person before him had gotten from God.

In **1 Kings 17:8-16**, the widow's needs were met through the famine period because she catered for the man of God.

In **2 Kings 4:8-36**, the Shunammite again was moved to be generous towards the man of God, and through this she got her blessing.

In **Genesis 18:1-14**, Abraham hosted God at dinner, and the promises of twenty-five years were fulfilled in just one day. Though Sarah doubted God's ability to deliver her miracle as was spoken, God overrode her doubt and gave her laughter. When your time comes, your doubt will not play a part as God will override your doubt.

The unimaginable urge to pray.

Human beings can tap into the warehouse of God through prayer. As generous as God is, He will not give you what you did not ask for, so therefore it is imperative that Christians pray at all times, as there lies their victory and provision.

Whenever we call upon God, He will answer and show us great and mighty things that we do not know (**Jeremiah 33:3**).

In **1 Samuel 1:10-18**, Hannah prayed and her miracle was delivered to her hands.

In **1 Chronicles 4:9-10**, Jabez prayed to God.

In **2 Chronicles 32:1-22**, Hezekiah prayed.

In **2 Chronicles 20:1-20**, Jehoshaphat prayed.

Henry J. Heinz (1844-1919) by Silvia Leigh

Later in life he went to London with a case filled with his products and the biggest shops there did a contract with him to supply them indefinitely. He was now as famous in Europe as he was in the US.

During the recession his business failed and he was declared bankrupt. But he prayed and he started again 'from scratch' paying all his debts. This second beginning became the road for his greater success. He opened more factories. He bought acres of land to produce his own fresh vegetables.



H J Heinz was one of the first American companies to introduce staff welfare facilities. He insisted that each of his factories should have dining, locker and dressing rooms for the staff. Each factory had a gym and a swimming pool for the staff. He provided beautiful uniforms to all his workers who had free hospital and dental treatments, free life insurance and further education facilities. There were hair and nail dressing saloons in each factory for the benefit of his female workers. The result was that very few workers resigned their jobs at Heinz and did their best to make great profits. He was one of the most loved millionaires ever.

He was a smallish man with a big moustache. Very active, he did not like to seat for too long in his office. He was a man who loved God and the people. He was always ready to teach others from the Bible or on any other subject. He invented many recipes. He insisted that all his factories should be very clean. All his selling methods were straight and fair. His products were so good that he did not have competition. At the time of his death his company had 6523 employees, 26 factories, 227 offices and 100,000 acres of farmland. But his real life passion was to serve the Lord Jesus Christ. With his money he sponsored countless projects in the churches.

After Heinz died and the family opened his will, at the top of the page it was written:

'I am looking forward to the time when my earthly career shall end. I desire to set forth, at the very beginning of this my Will, as the most important item in it, my confession of my faith in Jesus Christ as my Saviour forever'

This year (2013) the richest man on earth Warren Buffet bought Heinz Company for \$28 billion. Only God can give such an increase! You do not have to steal or to cheat to be wealthy. Just seek God with all your heart and money shall follow you! This is the promise of God!

"So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need' (Mat 6:31-33).

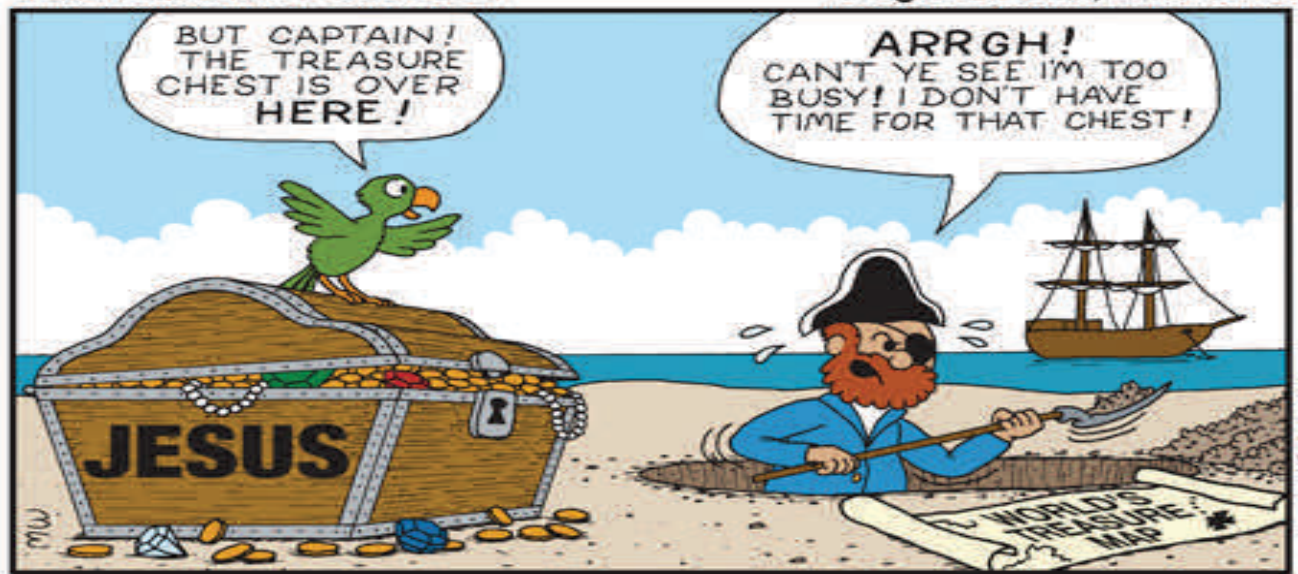

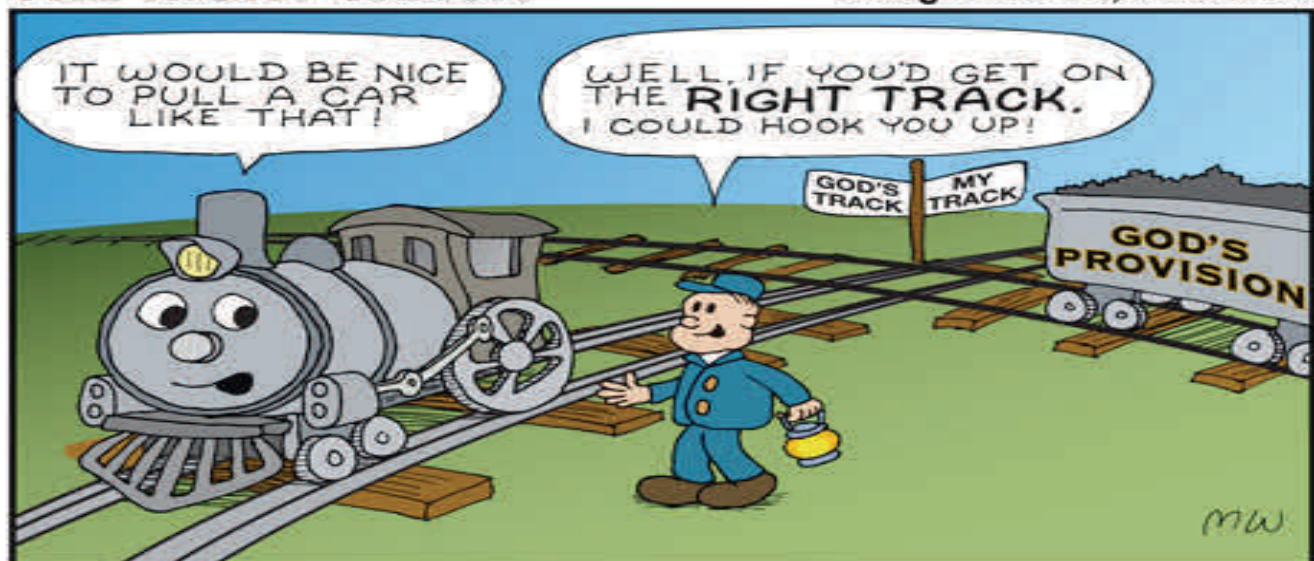
