"JESUS, EXAMPLE OF PERFECT LOVE" BY PASTOR YEMISI BAM-GBOSE

JOHN 15:12-19

Jesus is the embodiment of true and perfect love.

Love without stain and hypocrisy

A sacrificial love to His worst enemies; those who nailed Him to the cross.

It was because of love that He came to save the ungodly from hell fire and doom.

Romans 5:8 says: "But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

For scarcely would a man die for a righteous person, not to talk of dying for sinners if not for His perfect love.

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

The evidence of Jesus' love for the world is that He gave up His life for us.

God gave us His only begotten son because of His love for mankind.

Jesus was motivated to die for us because of the glory that awaits Him, He gave us everlasting life because of His love for us, His created beings.

Jesus has shown us how to love by first loving us.

Love does not take record of wrongs or become vengeful

Father, let my lips be anointed with the oil of thanksgiving all day long in Jesus name.




