"JESUS THE BURDEN BEARER" BY PASTOR YEMISI BAM-GBOSE



MATTHEW 11:25-30

"At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank Thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because Thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes. Even so, Father: for so it seemed good in Thy sight. All things are delivered unto Me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and He to whomsoever the Son will reveal Him. Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light".

Burden is a load that is borne with difficulty; A weight too heavy to carry on your own; A life saddled with difficult tasks; The load of oppression, To weigh down lives with problems, To weigh down with problems that is not of your own making.

Burden Bearer is someone who comes along to carry the load that is too heavy for you to carry. Someone who comes along and says, let me help you take away the burden.

He can come to our level in order to assist us bear the burden.

An African adage says, "Anyone that requires help must ask for one."

Jesus is our burden bearer, He said to us, come to me

He gave us an open invitation that is too attractive to ignore; bring your worries and He takes them off you and gives you His life that is worry free.

Our responsibility is to go to Him with our worries and anxiety and He will help us out.

We should go to Jesus and exchange our heavy burdens for His own that is easy to carry.

Some of us are carrying loads that does not belong to us, per adventure you are carrying another man's load, when we cry to the Burden bearer and He will come and help you out.

He is someone who comes to your aid, Someone ready to give you a helping hand anytime

Someone that comes to remove all that has been laden on you.

Sometimes evil burden can attach itself to you uninvited and refuses to go; As you cry to Jesus, He will come to your rescue in His Name.

Some burdens came about as a result of sin and disobedience. Psalm 107:17 says "Fools, because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted." Sin is an active agent to burdens.

The mad man of Gadara carried a burden placed on him by the devil and he could not put it down willingly.

Jesus has given us an open invitation to come to Him with our loads and heaven burdens just like the woman with the issue of blood went to Him and she came back with great news.

The load she was carrying was not a voluntary one, she sought help from all angles without success, the doctors failed her, friends and family members deserted her, she was seriously in debt as she had spent her income looking for help, looking for solution to her problem or someone that could take away her burden, but no one was able to do so. She became desperate in her search for help, and that led her to the Burden bearer and she was never disappointed as she came back home without the load she has been carrying for a long time.

It does not matter how long the problem has been in existence, just bring it to Jesus and you will never be disappointed.

Heavy burdens can throw many into depression, despair and sorrow, such was the story of the mad man of Gadara, his burden placed forcefully in him by the devil was too heavy for him to carry and no one was able to carry it for him, or even help him out. He was only fit to live among the dead, carry legions of demons, tormented day and night without a respite, until Jesus came to the scene, and He freed him from the torment and sorrow of living in a burial ground. This man was alive but living among the dead, his dwelling place was in the burial ground It does not matter how low you have gone or how saddled with pain you feel, if you can only come to Him, the Burden bearer, He will sort your life out and give you total freedom and liberty.

The devil put loads or burdens on his victims

There are various types of burdens:

1) Physical burdens, sickness and incurable diseases just like the woman with the issues of blood, Matthew 9:20-22, Matthew 8:14-17, Luke 17:11-19

2) Spiritual burdens, a person under a demonic oppression, **Luke 1:23-27**. The one with unclean spirit, this man was coming to church, but the devil came with him.

Even though he did not like the situation in which he found himself, there was nothing he could do about it. One day Jesus came to his rescue. Today, just like this man and the mad man of Gadara, Jesus will come to your rescue in Jesus name.

3) Marital Burdens: just like the woman at the well suffered many things in the hands of men, for she had gone through several husbands until Jesus came to rescue her. **John 4:10-24**

4) Material Burdens, poverty, lack and insufficiency are all material burdens, many people are under this terrible burden, all their personal effort yield no desired result at all.

The widow of Zarephath **1 Kings 17:8-16; 2 Kings 4:1-7**. The widow that was heavily indebted. As many that are under a financial burden, the Lord will deliver you today in Jesus name.

Some of other burdens are unexplainable tragedy in family, curses, darkness, captivity, physical imprisonment etc. Sometimes sin allows people to be ensnared by heavy burdens

In the heart of every sinner is a heavy burden that only the blood of Jesus can remove permanently.

The choice is for those carrying burdens to run to the Burden bearer.

Jesus does not discriminate, procrastinate, postpone, delay, or unable to help. He is never late and He is willing to help all those that run to Him.

He came to this world for that reason, to destroy the works of the devil.

He came to release those that have been oppressed by demonic powers that are stronger than them, that only the stronger power can remove.

FOR BURDENS TO BE LIFTED, CERTAIN CONDITIONS MUST BE FULFILLED.

A) There must admit that you have a problem or burden, **Mark 1:40-41**

B) You just be willing to be helped **John 5:2-9**

C) You have to cry to the burden bearer for help. **Mark 10:45-52**

What are the benefits we can enjoy with this Burden bearer?

- 1) Freedom from sickness, oppression.
- 2) Constant supply of needs.
- 3) Protection from invasion
- 4) Liberty from demonic influence
- 5) Rest from toiling and labouring
- 6) He will Shield and defend us
- 7) He is just and fair in judgment

For this reason was Jesus came to the world to destroy the works of the devil.

The good news is that Jesus is the answer to all these burdens, He is willing to carry them for us if only we can run to Him for help.

Also, it depends on your proximity to the One who will help you carry your burden, if you are far away, how can He assist you, if you walk closely with Him, You will be at arm's length for assistance.

We will need to walk closely with Him and allow Him to walk closely with us as this will put the enemy at bay.

All we need to do is to surrender all to Him.

AFTER YOUR BURDEN IS GONE; WHAT NEXT?

- a) Learn to praise Him
- b) Give Him thanks generously
- c) Worship Him perpetually
- d) You must testify and witness of Him
- e) Put Him first in everything.
- f) Abide with Him

In the main bible passage, He gave an invitation to come to Him if you labour and are heavy laden and He will give you rest. This invitation is valid today. If you come to Him, He will take away your burden.

You must be willing to take your burden to Him for Jesus to assist you.

Today, as you call upon Him, He will answer you and give you rest.

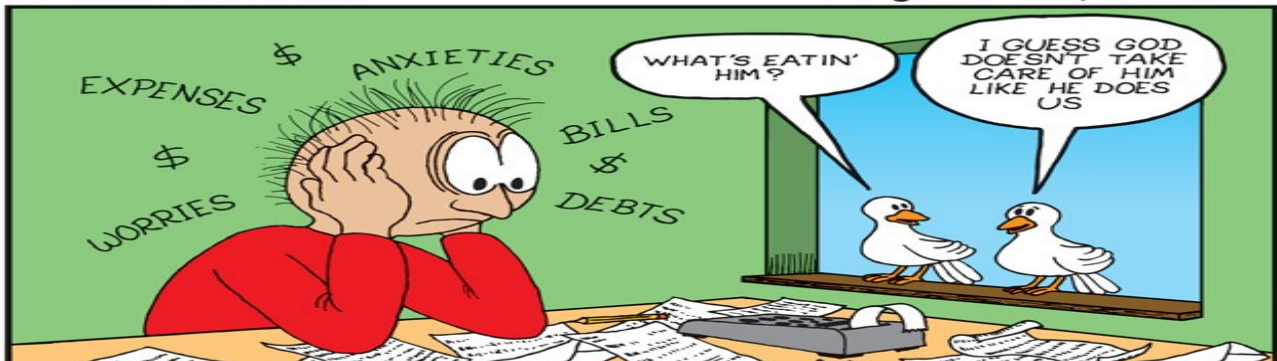
