“JESUS THE FRUITFUL VINE” BY PASTOR YEMISI BAMGBOSE

JOHN 15:1-9



Jesus is the fruitful vine and as a fruitful vine, He is the only one that can make us fruitful in life.

Fruitfulness in marriage, career, business, education and all endeavours is only possible when we are linked up with Him.

In this passage, Jesus made it clear that for any of us to be fruitful in life; we have to abide in Him.

He introduced Himself as the true vine

He called us, His children, the branches and His Father as the vine dresser.

The Father makes fruitfulness a possibility

Genesis 1:28

God spoke unto His creation to be fruitful, multiply, to replenish, to have dominion and to subdue the earth.

It is part of the package for us to experience fruitfulness in life, provided we remain as part of the vine.

It is the responsibility of the gardener or vine dresser to tender the fruitful branch, so that it can produce more fruits and to quickly detach the dead branch from the vine in order not to hinder the rest of the tree.

Jesus, on the other hand, allow nutrients to pass through to the branches so that it can produce better and bigger fruits.

Without adequate nutrients and water, the fruits may remain undeveloped, or possibly dry up without realising its full potential.

Our fruitfulness in the business world is only possible by our connecting with the fruitful vine.

Luke 5:1-7

Peter toiled all night and caught nothing, he was a very skilful fisher man, but his personal experience in that field failed that day; he became a failure, dejected and frustrated because of one night of failed trial.

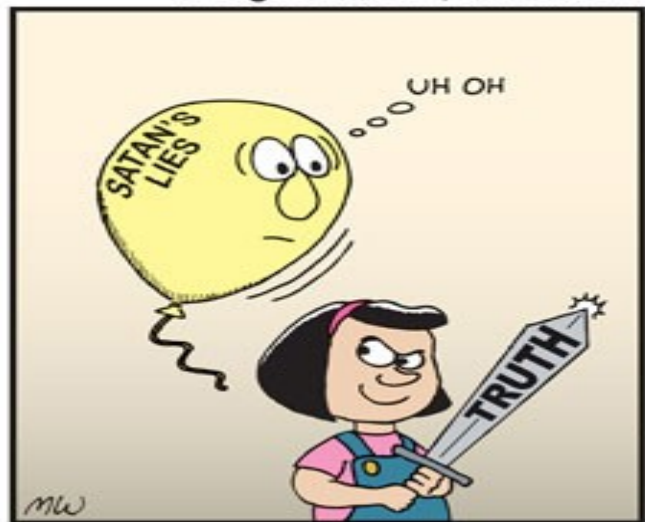
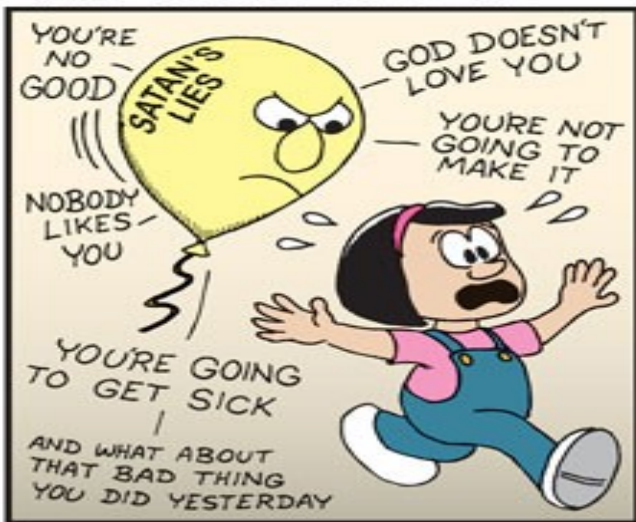
