"COVENANT MONTH OF BLESSINGS" BY PASTOR YEMISI BAMGBOSE

PSALM 89:20-37



What is a covenant? It is a mutual agreement between two individuals or more; it could be written or verbal, and must be kept by the parties involved. Sometimes, such a covenant can have a token or seal to make it authentic.

A covenant comes with conditions that must be adhered to by the parties involved, and failure to honour and keep it may result in serious consequences for the covenant-breaking party.

We have seen covenants between:

God and man - Genesis 12:2-3, Deuteronomy 28:1-3, Jeremiah 33:19-22

Man and man - Genesis 26:28-3, ISamuel 18:3

Man and woman - Genesis 2:23-25

Nation and another nation - Joshua 9:15

Family and family - Genesis 31:50-52

We have seen covenants between God and man that are still in operation up until today. For instance, in **Genesis 8:20-22**, Noah offered a burnt offering unto God immediately after the flood. As a result, God entered into an everlasting covenant with the human race, which said, "As long as the earth remains, there will be day and night. Winter and summer, sowing and reaping shall not cease". This particular covenant is still binding today. We still have day and night, and we still have winter and summer. The law of sowing and reaping is all around us because of that singular act performed by Noah, thus causing God to enter into that covenant.

We must also note that God does not just enter into covenants with man without a provoking act on behalf of the human party. For instance, this particular covenant was provoked by Noah's burnt sacrifice of clean animals to Him.

Again, God entered into another covenant with man in **Jeremiah 33:19-22**, which says, "And the word of the Lord came unto Jeremiah, saying, Thus saith the Lord; If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me".

You can see in this scripture that God views covenants as very serious, especially the ones He makes with His children.

Another important covenant made between God and man was in the Garden of Eden, which was fulfilled in Christ and ratified by His blood on the cross of Calvary. Jesus gave us a new covenant in His blood.

An example of a covenant made between man and God can be seen also in the story of Hannah in **I Samuel 1:11**. She asked God for a son and promised to give the son back to God; a promise she later fulfilled.

In the example of covenants made between man and man, there is Isaac versus Abimelech and his people, and this can be found in Genesis 26:28-33.

Another example of covenants made is a covenant made between husband and wife. This type of covenant is life-binding.

A covenant made between two nations could be seen as a treaty entered into by the two leaders of the respective nations. This treaty must be honoured and adhered to by the citizens of both nations. So therefore, we should come into this new month with a sense of responsibility towards covenants made between God and man.

We should make November our covenant month where all our past vows are paid and also remind God of His promises made to us since the beginning of this year. We should come into the presence of God throughout this month with a heart full of gratitude for all His numerous blessings in the past few months.

Because of the covenant made with the people mentioned above, they enjoyed the following blessings as a result:-

- I) Noah spared the world from flooding, and we now enjoy the blessings of day and night, and of sowing time and harvest time. Noah also provoked God into giving us universal blessings.
- 2) Hannah asked God for a son and she honoured her word by giving the son back to God; consequently, God gave her many children in return.
- 3) David got an everlasting kingship because he was a true worshipper of God.

Every born-again Christian has free access to the presence of God by the blood of Jesus. His blood has given us victory over the devil and his agents. The blood has made us partakers in divine inheritance. We have hope of eternal glory. Our names are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. We are eternally secured. We can call God our Father. We have the gift of the Holy Spirit, which is our seal until the day of redemption.

God will always honour every word that has proceeded out of His mouth. We are the ones that usually break our covenant, sometimes without considering the implication that follows our actions. Hannah brought the child back to God in fulfilment of her promise. Noah gave God the best and cleanest animals as a burnt offering and not leftovers'. David was a true worshipper; he worshipped God unashamedly. He wrote psalms, songs and hymns in his appreciation to God who made him the king and kept him alive and safe from his enemies. In Psalm 34:1-3, He danced before God who made him a king, and he commanded his soul, spirit and everything within him to praise God. No wonder God entered into such a covenant with him.

As we enter this month of November, I would like us to be like King David and dance before God our Maker, Protector, preserver and Provider unashamedly. Show your sincere appreciation to Him that has kept us alive, and saved us from sin and the damnation of hell fire, terror and demonic influences.

This month, you should come before God with a heart full of gratitude and thanksgiving. Do not wait to be cajoled before casting your crown before your Maker in worship.

Psalm 100:1-5 (Message) "On your feet now—applaud God! Bring a gift of laughter, sing yourselves into His presence. Know this: God is God, and God, God. He made us; we didn't make Him. We're His people, His well—tended sheep. Enter with the password: 'Thank you!' Make yourselves at home, talking praise. Thank Him. Worship Him. For God is sheer beauty, all—generous in love, loyal always and ever."

This month, we should discard all manmade pretence of stiffness and applaud God with our shout of thanksgiving, and rejoice like those that have won the battle of life. We should use the password of thank you for our benefits, blessings, provisions and protection. We should come before Him with gifts, laughter and worship God in the beauty of His Holiness.

Pay all your pending vows. God will always honour His own side of the covenant, but we too must be men and women of integrity by doing exactly what we have promised to do. You can provoke Heaven to respond to you this month, especially as the year is almost running to an end. Do something unusual this month that will make Heaven mark your voice/request and send an urgent answer to you. You can follow the pattern of the people mentioned above and the Holy Spirit can in-

spire you to do the right thing for yourself.

May the month of November give birth to our own miracle and blessings in Jesus nameamen


