



As a man from an African descendant, I remember my parents telling me that "the only way to success is through hard work". For many years, this was my driving force towards achieving success. Working hard is undoubtedly a tool in achieving success. But really, is working hard the only way to success?

I have come across different types of people both successful and unsuccessful people. In the quest for success, I have read many books that teach success and I have spoken to successful people.

Some people say working hard paid off while some say working smart is the major driver for success. The question now is: **WORKING HARD or WORKING SMART?** There is a fine line between working hard and working smart...

<u>Working Hard</u>: "characterized by care and *perseverance in carrying out tasks* or *working tirelessly*" – [the free dictionary]

Hard work certainly will propel success...that's true to an extent – if you put effort and focus into something, you're going to achieve more than if you go at it in a half-hearted way. But it's all too easy to get sucked into working long hours, ticking tasks off a list, without being all that effective or successful.

Those that work hard usually evaluate success based on inputs such as the number of hours they work and the number of tasks they accomplish in a day or in a week and ultimately seek a large reward.

Typically hard work means something like 60 or 70 hours a week, working at home in the evenings and weekends, and continuously juggling multiple projects in a frantic attempt to get them all done. In as much this can result into success, it can also go without being recognised and without achieving success. Working too hard can have a really negative effect on your quality of life, too. Long hours and the pressure to keep doing *more* can lead to stress, burn out, depression, or just that miserable feeling of *is this all there is to life?*

<u>Working Smart</u>: "Characterized by *sharp quick thought; bright - this mean working intelligently*" Capable of making adjustments that resemble human decisions, especially in response to changing circumstances - [the free dictionary]

Those that work smart usually evaluates success based on the amount of discretionary time they have to do whatever it is they want to do.

Smart workers don't focus on inputs they focus on prioritizing in order to achieve the most valuable outputs in the most efficient ways. Smart workers usually have a much better work-life balance, are entrepreneurs, are able to identify their strengths and

weaknesses, and manage time effectively.

For example, a smart worker will realize that they are more productive during a certain time of day and will batch their tasks based on difficulty to match with when they are most productive.

Tips for working smart:

- <u>Understand your strengths and weaknesses</u> and try to take on projects that match your strengths while delegating tasks that fall within your weaknesses.
- <u>Don't focus on completing a lot of tasks</u>, focus on completing the most important tasks that will have the greatest impact on whatever you are doing.
- <u>Education is your best friend</u>. Working smart is all about understanding the big picture. You need to constantly learn and evolve your skill set.
- <u>Leverage your resources</u>, your network, and your connections. You have to understand what and who you have around determine your success to an extent.
- <u>Build for the future</u> while being able to sustain tomorrow.
- Know when to cut your losses. We all make mistakes, learn when you have made a mistake and move on.
- Look for the shortcuts. This doesn't mean cut corners in a way that makes your work less valuable or complete. It means, understanding the regular process that is required to accomplish something and then understanding if that whole process is necessary. Is there a way to complete the same task with the same quality of work but in a more efficient way?
- Work hard at working smart!

Managing Money- Budget Basis by About.com

For most people, the word "budget" conjures up thoughts of penny-pinching and the unpleasant task of crunching numbers. This couldn't be further from the truth. A budget is at the cornerstone of a solid financial foundation, regardless of your situation, and it isn't that hard to do.

What is a Budget?

A budget is nothing more than a breakdown and plan of how much money you have coming in and where it goes. Tracking Income

Take out your checkbook or pull your latest bank statement to help you with this step. Jot down how much you spend on things like utilities, groceries, entertainment, subscriptions, and so on.

The Bottom Line

You should now have all of the information needed to help you create your budget. So, go ahead and total up your monthly income and all of your monthly expenses. Subtract your expense total from your income total and you'll have either a positive or negative number. If you have a positive number, congratulations, you are spending less than you earn. Don't worry if you have a negative number. The whole reason for creating a budget is to identify deficiencies and find out how to address them.

Now that you can visually see how much you fall short, you can adjust your spending or saving in certain areas to improve the situation. Oftentimes you'll realize that by just making a few small adjustments to your spending habits, you can significantly improve your situation. Maybe this means cutting back on one of your magazine subscriptions, eating out one time less a month, or even just hitting the matinee instead of the prime time movie.

Typically, just saving a few dollars here and there can be enough to not only make sure you spend less than you earn, but also apply a few extra dollars to things like high-interest credit card debt or your retirement savings.
