"GOD'S HERITAGE" By Pastor Yemisi Bamgbose

Psalm 127:1-5.

"Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain. It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep. Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward. As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. Happy is the man that hath his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate."

What is a heritage? Something that comes or belongs to one by reason of birth; an inherited lot or portion. Something reserved for one.

The scripture above confirms that children are God's heritage and not man.

God owns them, he created them for His pleasure

Children as a matter of fact belong to God and not their parents, although the parents are the custodian, caretaker, steward, or an administrator but not the owner.

God created children and gave them as gifts to their parents to nurture and care for.

If children are God's gifts, they are to be handled with care and all diligence.

Not to be used, misused, abused, damaged, but to be tenderly cared for, provided for, loved and looked after.

Children as a reward are to give joy and gladness to their parents, because they are the reward of their union as husband and wife.

DAY 29


Bless God for His faithfulness, for His protection and security over the lives of our children in the past months and pray that they will not be influenced by evil forces in Jesus name.


