

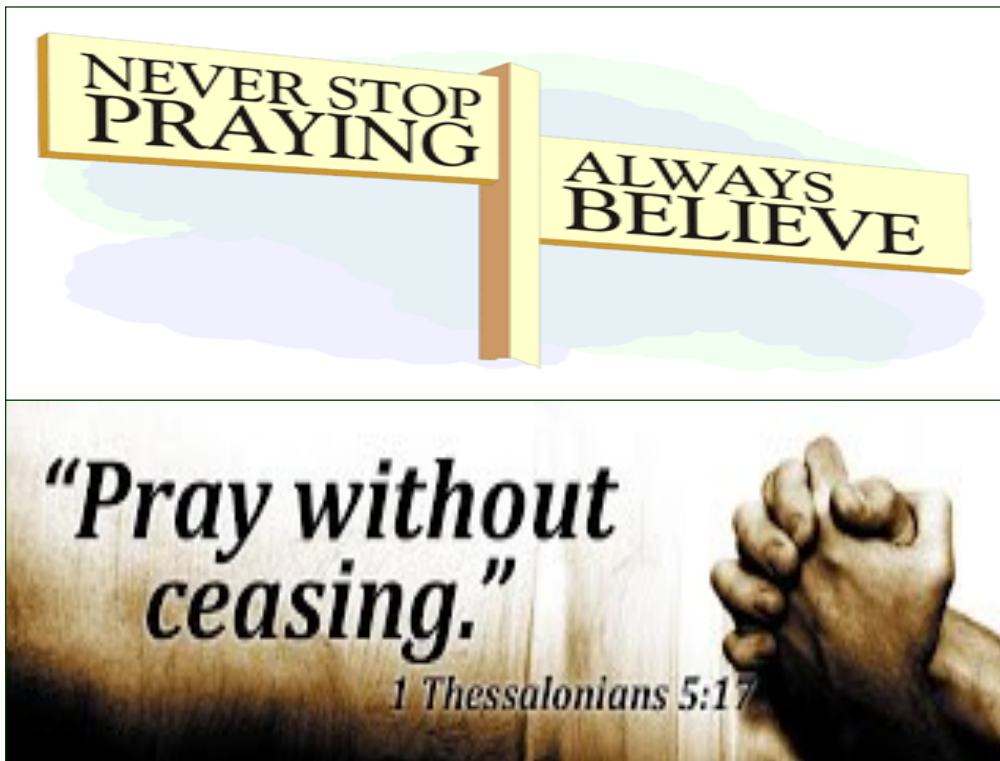

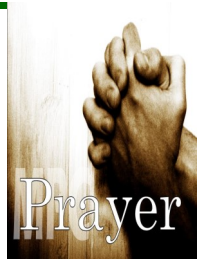

“PRAYER” By Pastor Yemisi Bamgbose

LUKE 11:1-13



What is prayer?

Prayer is engaging the help of heaven to move situations on the earth.

It is the master key that unlocks the barrier to your progress.

It is engaging the hand of God to move in your favour.

It is a means of engaging and enlisting the help of God on a matter and seeking a divine solution to it.

In prayer, there are crucial principles to follow in order to generate desired answers

Matthew 7:7 says, “ask, you shall receive, seek, you shall find, knock, the door shall be opened to you”.

Jesus said, if only you will ask, that what you ask shall be given to you

You engage your heart, mouth and your brain in prayer.

Needs spur people to pray, but it is good to make prayer our daily habit

Prayer is acknowledging our human frailty, weakness, our dependency on the unlimited God

Prayer is agreeing with heaven's will on a matter and cooperating on the subject matter

Whenever our will match up with His will, you can guarantee an answer from God

It is also identifying your needs and presenting them before your Father

Present them unto God in the place of prayer

What do you ask for in prayer?

John 14:13-14 says “And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask anything in my name, I will do it”. You can ask anything in His name, He will do it.

ASK WITHOUT WAVERING (James 4:3) Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

I John 3:22 “And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight”.

Ephesians 3:20 “Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us”.

John 16:23-24 “And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full”. Ask continually and continuously until your joy is full.

Many will make a request unto the king of their nation, but because they are ordinary men, they may not have their request met because of their own human limitations. Your request should be made only to God and not to man as man may not have answers to your request, but God has the resources, ability, power and experience to do more than you can ever ask or think.

Isaiah 45:11 “Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me”. I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded. I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, not for price nor reward, saith the Lord of hosts.

Hannah prayed to God for a child and had her petition answered (**1 Samuel 1:27-28**) For this child I prayed; and the Lord hath given me my petition which I asked of him: Therefore, also I have lent him to the Lord; as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the Lord. And he worshipped the Lord there.

Elisha asked Elijah for a hard thing and got his request answered (**2 Kings 2:9-15**). And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me. And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: nevertheless, if thou see me when I am taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be so. And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces. He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan; And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where is the Lord God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

And when the sons of the prophets which went to view at Jericho saw him, they said, The spirit of Elijah doth rest on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed themselves to the ground before him.

When confronted with powers of darkness or facing the impossible situation, that is the time to pray. **1 Kings 18:36-39** *“And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word. Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the Lord God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again. Then the fire of the Lord fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The Lord, He is the God; the Lord, He is the God”.*

Sometimes you may need the agreement of other brethren concerning an issue; Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven (**Matthew 18:19**).

Exodus 15:25 says *“And he cried unto the Lord; and the Lord shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and an ordinance, and there he proved them”*

Jabez called upon God and his story changed in **1 Chronicles 4:10** *“And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested”.*

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive (**Matthew 21:22**).

And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He heareth us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him (**1 John 5:14 -15**).

Ask ye of the Lord rain in the time of the latter rain; so the Lord shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field (**Zechariah 10:1**).

In that night did God appear unto Solomon, and said unto him, Ask what I shall give thee (**2 Chronicles 1:7**).

And Jacob asked him, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore is it that thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there (**Genesis 32:29**).

And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto Him: and when he was come near, He asked him, Saying, What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. And Jesus said unto him, receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God (**Luke 18:40-43**).

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints (**Ephesians 6:18**).

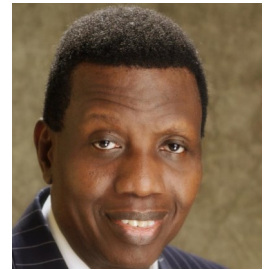

Testimony Corner

My Testimony by Lukman Mayegun

Glory be to Almighty God, I would like to share my testimony. I am 22 years old. I came to the United Kingdom in December 2005 with my brother, then I was fifteen and he was eight years old. Due to family problems and for our safety and security, my sister whom we came to visit decided we should stay behind and live with her.

My sister and her husband have been very nice to me and my brother looking after us and taking good care of us. I enrolled in secondary school and finished with 7As including Maths and English, I finished my secondary education, got an admission to North West Kent College to study Business with Marketing. I achieved numerous destinations and many educational awards.

While studying I got some job offers, I went for interview and I was offered the job but I was asked to provide my passport which was most likely expired already. I was lucky I was able to complete my college education, then I became stagnant (**Almighty Lord will never make our lives stagnant in Jesus name**).

I could not work, could not go to school, I was just at home all day every day, I did not even have a GP all this while due to the fact that I don't have my paper. Everywhere I go your status is the first thing they want to ascertain. For many years I was at home, I tried as much as I can to make the best of my time studying and learning new things, I was able to learn how to design websites and a bit of programming amongst others.

A family lawyer advised us that we could win our case on humanitarian grounds, so we decided to try it. My application was refused without right of appeal and I was given time to be removed from the UK. The lawyer advised that we should go to court but before any of that happened, about 6 immigration officers stumped our house in April and arrested me, I have never been in that situation before. I was dragged out of my home at 6.30am to immigration removal centre and I was there for ten days before I was released on bail to sign at the police station every week. Glory be to God, I was granted right of appeal to compile all my evidence and reasons why I cannot return to my country.

Here work began! – We started compiling documents to prove I have no other family in my country. I rely financially and emotionally on my sister and committed to each other, we shared affection and unconditional love among ourselves.

Monday 19 August was our court date, we came to church very early in the morning, pastor prayed with us and assured us all is well. When we got to court God's miracle began to work because there were three cases, ours was the second one but the Judge called our case first, However, devil started his old tricks, one of our document was incomplete. We had to rush from the city, the court venue, back to Woolwich and then back to the court.

We got back in time even though I was the last person they attended to, the outcome was God's doing. I and my sister gave oral and written evidence- which the Judge described as credible and has no reason to doubt it. The Judge ruled in my favour.

I won the case on two grounds, both under Immigration Rules and Human Right. I praise God Almighty for what He has done for me. Praise the Lord!!!
